The system, designed by Rob Paulus Architects and installed by Thomas Drexler of T-Drex Construction, will capture rainwater, HVAC condensation and evaporative cooler runoff. The 2 giant stainless steel collector tanks, positioned prominently at the front of the building, have the capacity to hold a combined 36,000 gallons of water and in an average rainfall year, the system will collect in excess of 100,000 gallons. TriSports.com was awarded a grant from the City of Tucson Conservation Program to help offset the cost of installation.

The decision to install rainwater harvesting was an easy one for the company to make. TriSports.com's business model is run by a set of core values that highlights sustainability at the top of its list. "Our rainwater harvesting system is a really great complement to the rest of our lesser seen sustainability efforts", Claggett said. Other sustainable programs the company has in place include utilizing natural day lighting in all areas of the building, re-using over 95% of inbound order packaging and rewarding employees for bicycle commuting. "The next step", says Claggett, "is solar power".

TriSports.com's rainwater harvesting system is said to be the largest private commercial system in the Western United States.
